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e. CARES Act ODOT Funds Disbursement

Background: The recently-enacted "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act", or CARES Act, includes provisions for new transit funding to assist providers during the COVID-19 pandemic. Oregon's allocation of these funds under the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5311 Formula Grants for Rural Areas Program is \$42,686,023 of which CCATD is eligible to apply for \$214,766. Eligible project types include operations, lost revenue, capital purchases related to coronavirus prevention/protection, and administrative leave salaries. Other COVID-19-related expenses not specifically called out in the CARES Act may also be eligible.

Recommended Motion: Move to authorize management to apply for CARES Act funding under FTA Section 5311.

f. Rural Veterans Healthcare Transportation (RVHT) Grant program

Background: The goal of the RVHT Program is to overcome transit-based barriers between veterans living in rural areas and the healthcare services they've earned. Through awards of operations and purchased services grants to eligible STF Agencies, RVHT's objective is to inspire innovative local solutions to transit challenges. ODOT Public Transportation Division anticipates making grant awards between \$10,000 and \$50,000. Application due May 18, 2020

Recommended Motion: Move to authorize management to apply for the Rural Veterans healthcare Transportation Grant program.
